Do you like your friends?

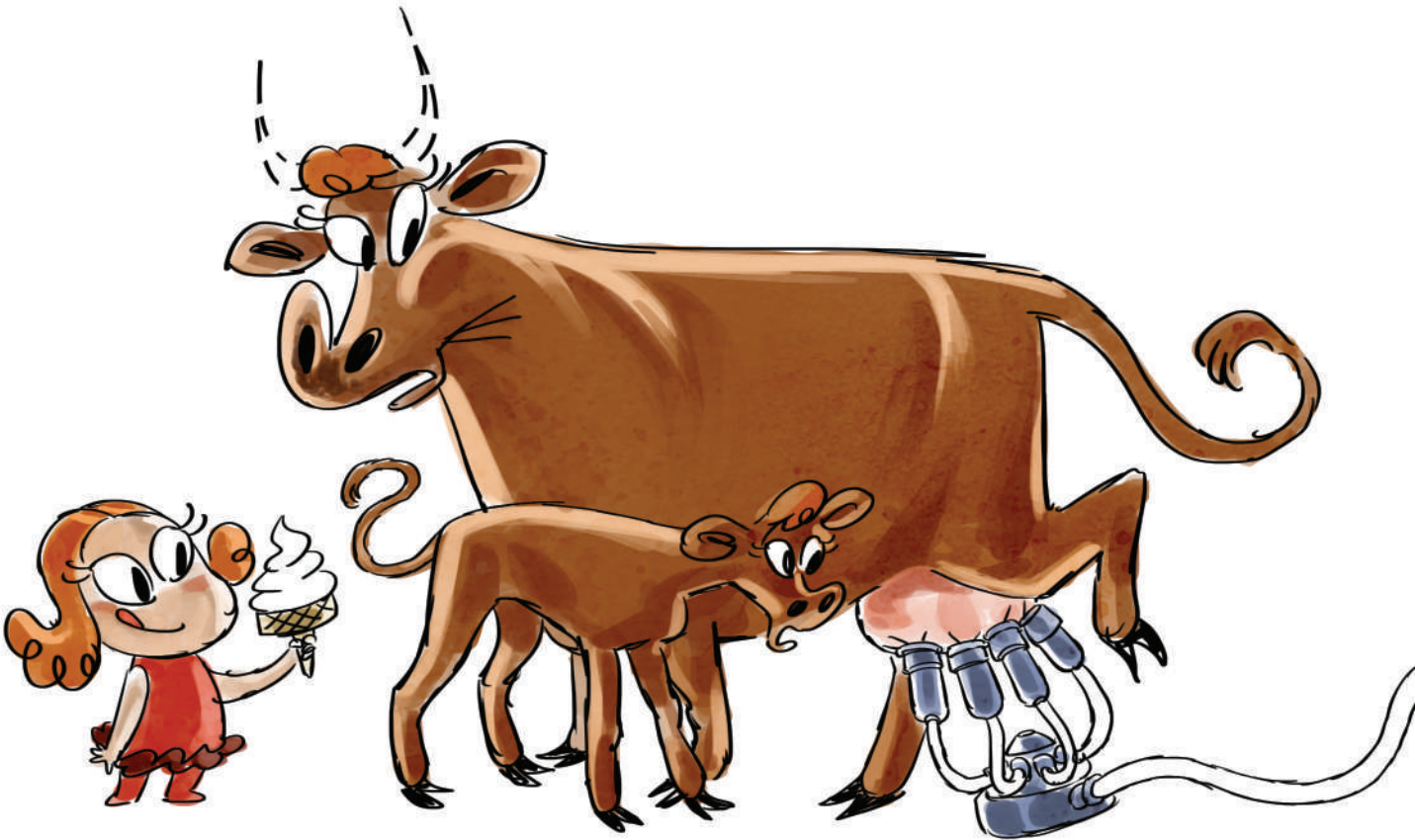


Cows have milk because they are mothers

The baby of a cow is called a calf.

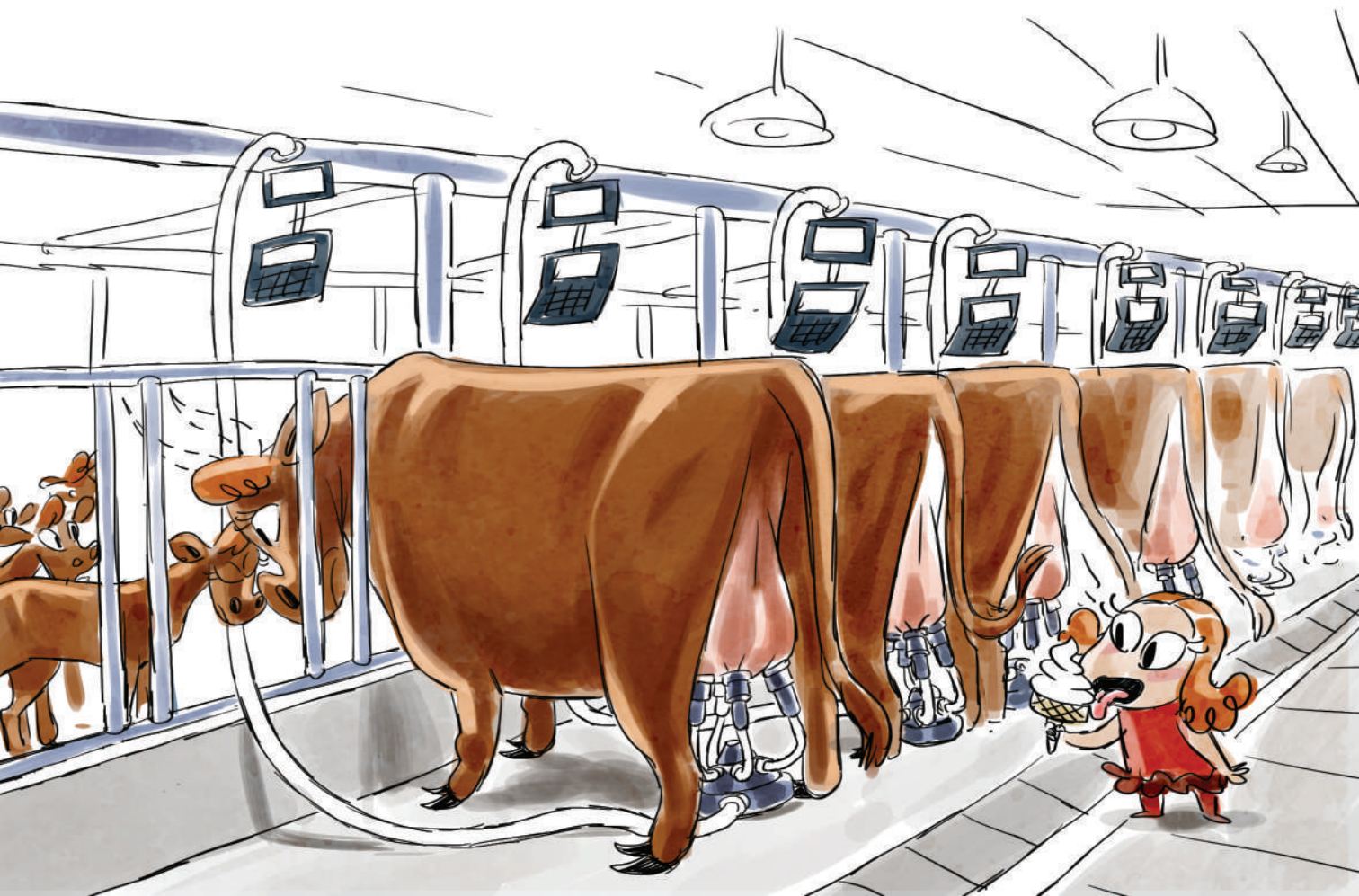
Cows give milk to their calves. Do you like milk?

Do you like leather gloves?

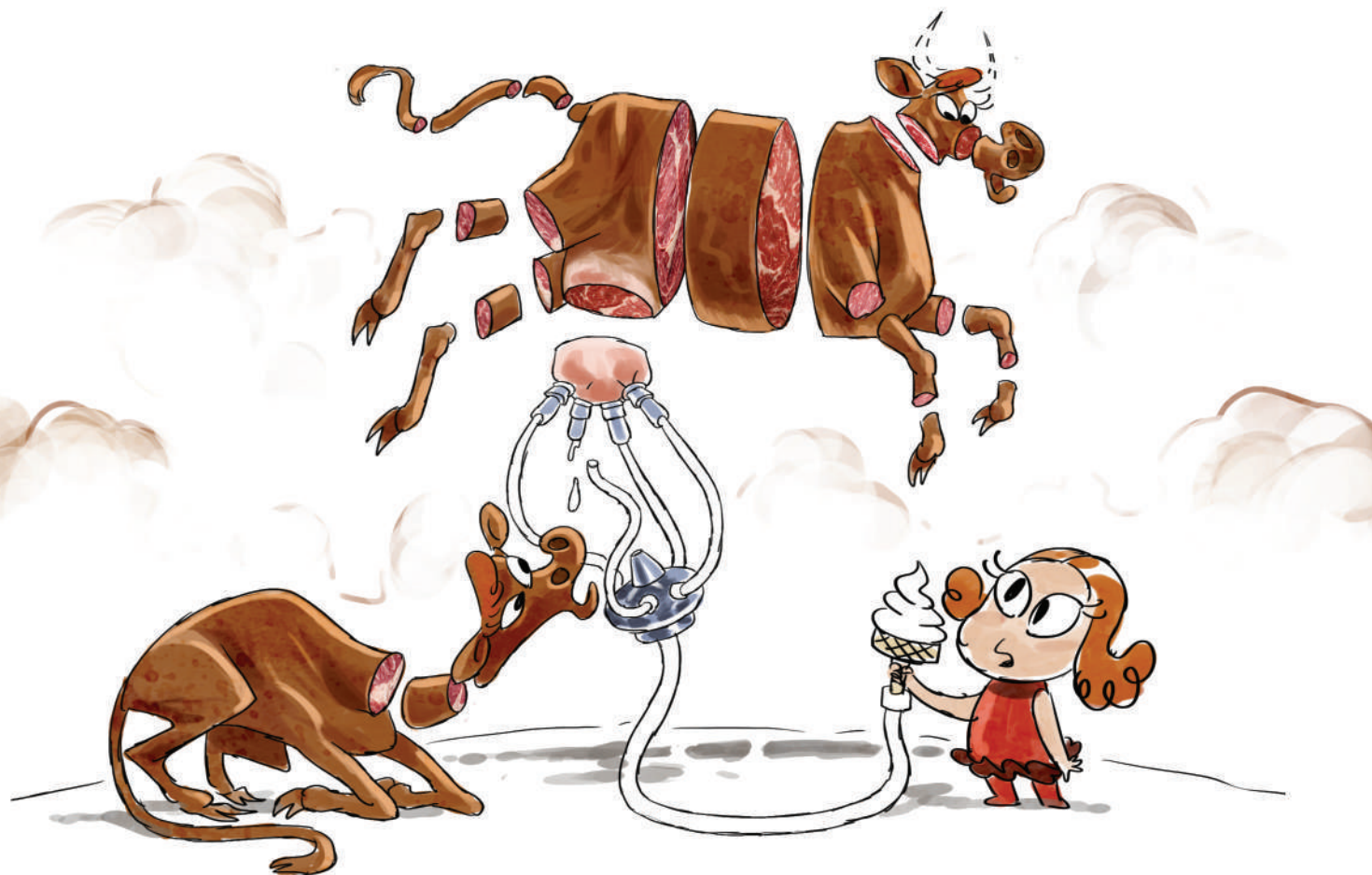




Cows like their lives. Do you like your life?
